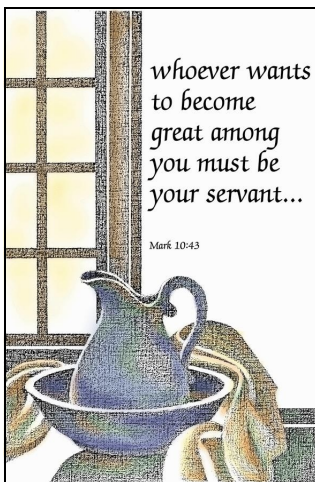
foyer with information on the backpacks and what to put in each backpack.
